

PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, Katherine Pyeatt respectfully petitions the FCC to institute a Rule Making proceeding to amend the FM Table of Allotments to add Channel 286A at Encinal, Texas, as that community's first aural broadcast transmission service.

DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 286A to Encinal, Texas as that community's first aural broadcast transmission service.

Encinal is an incorporated city with a population of 655 people according to the Texas State Data Center estimates of January 1, 1998. Encinal has its own pro-temp mayor, Javier Mancha, its own elementary school system, its own post office, its own volunteer fire department and a number of local churches.

Attached hereto is a channel study confirming that Channel 286A can be allocated to Encinal, Texas consistent with the FCC's FM separation rules. See revision of FM Assignment Policies and Procedures, 90 FCC 2d 88 (1992).


