

REPLY COMMENTS OF KATHERINE PYEATT

I, Katherine Pyeatt, ("Petitioner") hereby respectfully submits this reply to the Counterproposal filed by Annona Broadcasting Company in the above captioned proceeding.

DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 263A to Winnsboro, Texas, as that community's first competing FM service. Winnsboro is an incorporated city with a population exceeding 3,220 people. Winnsboro has its own mayor, Carolyn Jones, its own fire department, its own post office, school district and a number of local churches. It is my continued intention to apply for Channel 263A at Winnsboro, Texas, and after it is authorized, will promptly construct the new facility.

Annona Broadcasting Company proposes to allot Channel 263A to Annona, Texas, as that community's first local aural service in place of Channel 263A at Winnsboro, Texas. However, at the coordinates proposed by Annona Broadcasting Company (33/34/53 – 95/03/19), Channel 263A at Annona, Texas is short spaced by –17.2 Km to Channel 262A allocation at Fort Towson. See Attachment A.

Therefore, the FCC should deny Annona Broadcasting Company's Counterproposal for Channel 263A at Annona, Texas and allocate channel 263A to Winnsboro, Texas.

The information provided in these Reply Comments are correct and true to the best of my knowledge.


