DISCUSSION


Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 243A to **Oscoda**, Michigan, as that community's second competing FM service. The FCC data base currently shows 239C2 and 264C3 licensed to Oscoda, Michigan. **Oscoda** is an incorporated city with a population in excess of 6,700 people. **Oscoda** has its own township superintendent, Robert Stocker, its own school system, its own post office, its own fire department and a number of local churches.
