

DISCUSSION


Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 284A to **Antlers**, Oklahoma, as that community's second competing FM service. The FCC data base currently shows the vacant allotment 222C2 and the vacant allotment 272A at **Antlers**, Oklahoma. **Antlers** is an incorporated community with a population in excess of 2,500 people. **Antlers** has its own mayor, Roy Jackson, its own school system, its own post office, its own fire department and a number of local churches.
