Dear Ms. Salas:

On October 12, 2001, Karen Possner of BellSouth Corporation, Paul Sinderbrand of the Wireless Communications Association and undersigned counsel on behalf of AT&T Wireless Services, Inc. met with Monica Desai, legal advisor to Commissioner Martin, with regard to the above referenced proceeding. At that meeting, we discussed the "sunset" proposal submitted by the WCS community on October 4, 2001, that would address blanketing interference into WCS networks by transitioning SDARS repeaters from high power to standard power over time. We urged that the Commission include this proposal in any further notice of proposed rulemaking issued in this proceeding. We also urged that the Office of Engineering and Technology be given a larger role in resolving the technical issues presented in this docket. In addition, we discussed the fact that not a single WCS, MDS, or ITFS licensee has yet received any information on any SDARS standard power repeaters operating pursuant to STA.
