Dear Ms. Salas:

This letter serves as notification that on October 17, 2001, Luisa Lancetti and Charles McKee (by phone) representing Sprint PCS, met with Gregory Vadas, Stacy Jordan, Joseph Levin, Tom Navin and Patrick Webre of the Commission's Wireless Telecommunications Bureau and Joshua Swift of the Commissions Common Carrier Bureau.

Sprint PCS met with Commission representatives to discuss issues associated with the exchange of traffic between CMRS carriers and independent telephone companies. Specifically, Sprint PCS addressed those issues raised in CC Docket No. 01-92, Developing a Unified Intercarrier Compensation Regime, associated with wireless local calling areas and the application of access charges to such local traffic. Sprint PCS outlined the continuing refusal of independent local exchange carriers to acknowledge the local calling scope of wireless traffic and their refusal to enter into reciprocal compensation agreements under 47 U.S.C 251(b)(5). Sprint PCS urged the Commission to address the issue of intra-MTA traffic and its treatment.
