Dear Ms. Salas:

On Wednesday, October 31, 2001, Lawrence R. Sidman and Sara W. Morris of Verner, Liipfert, Bernhard, McPherson & Hand, on behalf of their client, Harris Corporation ("Harris"), spoke by telephone with Susan Eid, Legal Advisor to Chairman Michael K. Powell, to discuss issues in the above-referenced proceeding.

The undersigned provided information from Harris on current DTV market conditions, particularly concerning prices and availability of DTV transmission equipment. The discussion focused on various approaches, including flexibility in certain broadcaster requirements and criteria for evaluating waiver requests, that would enable the maximum number of broadcasters to meet the May 1, 2002 deadline. The attached document, which provides cost data for DTV facilities based on several scenarios, was provided to Ms. Eid.
