

Please see paragraph 27 of the referenced docket. I entreat you to find another portion of spectrum in which to place these SAVI signals. This proposed frequency range imposes on the weak signal area and the amateur TV portion of the amateur radio 70 cm band. (These types of proposals are expensive for the amateur community to continually fight against large commercial interests.) This docket is proposing to essentially allow continuous duty cycle transmission of signals from every UPS truck on the highway right in the middle of the amateur radio band. I strongly disagree with allowing this to happen. I am a concerned amateur radio operator and I do not want to see more of our spectrum taken away from us like this. SAVI should not have designed their equipment on these frequencies to sell it in the US. They are also incorrect to say that those frequencies are OK for them 'worldwide'. They are not allowed to be on that frequency in the majority of countries around the world. In fact, there are only 10 countries that will allow them on those frequencies. Please don't make the US to be the eleventh one to allow them into the 70 cm amateur radio band. I beg you to turn them away from the 70 cm band.
