

Respectfully I urge the FCC to decide in favor of RM-10209. The addition of the frequency spectrum between 5240.0 - 5400.0 kHz for use by the Amateur Radio Service is an important solution to solving the overcrowding in nearby amateur radio band allocations. In addition, this frequency range has proven through a number of on-the-air tests to be extremely useful during propagation limitations experienced on nearby bands. The Military Affiliate Radio System (MARS) makes extensive use of frequencies near the proposed band and it has proven to be very effective when 80 meters or 40 meters wasn't useful.
