On October 26, 2001, Verizon submitted additional information and data supporting the study performed by Cambridge Strategic Management Group (CSMG) that demonstrates how a per-line recovery mechanism would dramatically increase the telephone service bills for households with lower long distance usage. In response to staff requests, Verizon is submitting the spreadsheet model used by CSMG in its study.

The CSMG model is being submitted as proprietary in accordance with Section 0.459 of the Commission's Rules and should not be made routinely available for public inspection. The model is an internal work product of CSMG and considers it to be proprietary.
