PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Maurice Salsa (Petitioner), pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, hereby requests the commission to amend section 73.202 (b) of its rules, the FM Table of Allotments, to allot channel 230A (93.9 Mhz) at Erick, Oklahoma.

DISCUSSION

Erick, Oklahoma is an incorporated community of over 1,023 people. Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 230A to Erick, Oklahoma, as that community's first aural broadcast transmission service. Erick has its own mayor, Gayla Dunlop, its own post office, its own fire department, its own school district, its own city hall and a number of local churches. The proposed channel 230A will provide additional diversity and an outlet for local self-expression to Erick residents and therefore is in the public interest.

Attached hereto is a channel study confirming that Channel 230A can be allocated to Erick, Oklahoma consistent with the FCC's FM separation rules. See revision of FM Assignment Policies and Procedures, 90 FCC 2d 88 (1992).


