PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Maurice Salsa (Petitioner), pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, hereby requests the commission to amend section 73.202 (b) of its rules, the FM Table of Allotments, to allot channel 222A (92.3 Mhz) at Carter, Oklahoma.

DISCUSSION

Carter, Oklahoma is an incorporated community of over 286 people. Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 222A to Carter, Oklahoma, as that community's first aural broadcast transmission service. Carter has its own mayor, Gene Tayber, its own post office, its own fire department, its own school district, its own city hall and a number of local churches. The proposed channel 222A will provide additional diversity and an outlet for local self-expression to Carter residents and therefore is in the public interest.

Attached hereto is a channel study confirming that Channel 222A can be allocated to Carter, Oklahoma consistent with the FCC's FM separation rules. See revision of FM Assignment Policies and Procedures, 90 FCC 2d 88 (1992).


Petitioner hereby states that if the commission grants this petition, he will apply for the channel when it is allotted, and, if his application is granted, he will promptly build the station.


