**ORDER**

By the Accounting Policy Division, Common Carrier Bureau:

1. This Order dismisses the Request for Review filed by Hazelwood School District (Hazelwood), Florissant, Missouri, seeking review of a decision issued by the Universal Service Administrative Company's Schools and Libraries Division on August 27, 2001.<sup>1</sup> The Commission received Hazelwood's Request for Review on September 28, 2001.<sup>2</sup> Under section 54.720 of the Commission's rules, any such appeal must be filed within 30 days of the issuance of the decision that the party seeks to have reviewed.<sup>3</sup> Documents are considered to be filed with the Commission only upon receipt.<sup>4</sup> Because the instant Request for Review was not filed within the specified 30-day period, it will be dismissed without further consideration.


