REPLY COMMENTS OF MAURICE SALSA

I, Maurice Salsa, hereby respectfully submit this Reply to Comments filed by KTCY Licensing, Inc. ("KTCY") in the above captioned proceeding.

DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 285A to Broken Bow, Oklahoma, as that community's second local aural transmission service.

KTCY is the licensee of Radio Station KTCY (FM), Pilot Point, Texas operating on Channel 285C1. KTCY counterproposes that Channel 285C0 be added at Pilot Point, Texas and that Radio Station KTCY (FM)'s license be modified accordingly. Additionally, KTCY also counterproposes the addition of a third local service at Broken Bow, Oklahoma at Channel 265A in lieu of Channel 285A.

KTCY's proposal to substitute Channel 265A for Channel 285A at Broken Bow, Oklahoma is not a possibility due to a prior filed rulemaking petition for Albion, Oklahoma dated September 27, 2001 and date stamped by the FCC Mail Room on October 4, 2001. See attached Petition for Rule Making for Albion, Oklahoma filed by Maurice Salsa.

For the foregoing reasons, I urge the Commission to allot Channel 285A to Broken Bow, Oklahoma. Should the Commission allot Channel 285A to Broken Bow, Oklahoma, I will apply for Channel 285A, and after it is authorized, will promptly construct the new facility.






