

DISCUSSION


Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 278A to La Pryor, Texas, as that community's first aural broadcast transmission service. La Pryor is city with a population of 1,230 people as of January 1, 1998 according to the Texas State Data Center. As of March 1999, 37 business establishments in La Pryor had been given a credit rating by Dun & Bradstreet. La Pryor has its own City Councilmen, Mathew McHazlett, its own post office, its own school district and a number of local churches.
