Please accept these comments as restated below from Proponents original petition.

DISCUSSION

Cherokee, Oklahoma is a Census Designated Place (CDP) with a population exceeding 1,700 people. The proposed channel 237C2 would be the first aural broadcast transmission service to Cherokee and will provide additional diversity and an outlet for local self-expression to Cherokee residents and therefore is in the public interest. Cherokee has its own mayor, Karen Hawkins, its own school system, its own fire department, its own city hall, its own post office and a number of local churches.

Petitioner hereby states that if the commission grants this petition, he will apply for the channel when it is allotted, and, if his application is granted, he will promptly build the station.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Petitioner respectfully requests the commission to grant this petition and to allot channel 237C2 to Cherokee, Oklahoma.
