On behalf of our client The School Board of Broward County Florida ("School Board"), licensee of television station WPPB-TV, Channel 63, Boca Raton, Florida, we hereby notify you that the School Board has terminated the above referenced settlement agreement and, by this letter, hereby withdraws its request for approval of the settlement. The School Board is the assignee of the license of WPPB-TV from Channel 63 of Palm Beach, Inc., one of the parties to the settlement agreement.
