

Commissioner Camie J. Swanson-Hull

Camie J. Swanson-Hull was appointed to the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission on July 15, 1996, by Governor Evan Bayh.. On December 14, 1999, she was then appointed to a second term by Governor Frank O'Bannon. An Independent, Ms. Swanson-Hull's term expires January 1, 2004.

From 1983 to 1993, Commissioner Swanson-Hull worked as an attorney in the law firm of Rogers, Jones and Swanson-Hull, becoming partner in 1989. She subsequently served as a deputy attorney general and section chief for the Indiana Attorney General. From 1994 to her appointment, she was Director of Volunteer Services for the American Lung Association.

She is a member of the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners Board of Directors; the Committee on Consumer Affairs; the Committee on Telecommunications; and the Mentoring Committee. She is a member of the Mid-America Regulatory Conference; a member of the Advisory Council for the New Mexico State University Center for Public Utilities; and a member of the Energy Partnership Board, a joint initiative of the Department of Energy and the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners. She has also served as a member of the Advisory Council of the Board of Directors of the Electric Power Research Institute.

Commissioner Swanson-Hull earned a bachelor's degree with distinction from Indiana University in Fort Wayne and a Juris Doctorate from the Indiana University School of Law at Bloomington.
