PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, Robert Fabian respectfully petitions the FCC to institute a Rule Making proceeding to amend the FM Table of Allotments to add Channel 236A at **Cadillac**, Michigan.

DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 236A to **Cadillac**, Michigan, as that community's third competing commercial FM service. **Cadillac** is an incorporated township with a population in excess of 10,000 people. **Cadillac** has its own township mayor, Ronald Blancher, its own school system, its own post office, its own fire department and a number of local churches. The proposed channel 236A will provide additional diversity and an outlet for local self-expression to **Cadillac** residents and therefore is in the public interest.
