PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Maurice Salsa (Petitioner), pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, hereby requests the commission to amend section 73.202 (b) of its rules, the FM Table of Allotments, to allot channel 228A (93.5 Mhz) at Pittsburg, Oklahoma.

DISCUSSION

Pittsburg, Oklahoma is an incorporated community of over 280 people. Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 228A to Pittsburg, Oklahoma, as that community's first aural broadcast transmission service. Pittsburg has its own mayor, Bud Little, its own volunteer fire department, its own post office, its own school district including the Pittsburg High School, its own City Hall and a number of local churches. The proposed channel 228A will provide additional diversity and an outlet for local self-expression to Pittsburg residents and therefore is in the public interest.

Attached hereto is a channel study confirming that Channel 228A can be allocated to Pittsburg, Oklahoma consistent with the FCC's FM separation rules. See revision of FM Assignment Policies and Procedures, 90 FCC 2d 88 (1992).

Petitioner hereby states that if the commission grants this petition, he will apply for the channel when it is allotted, and, if his application is granted, he will promptly build the station.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Petitioner respectfully requests the commission to grant this petition and to allot channel 228A to Pittsburg, Oklahoma.
