If you have already installed a previous version of the Verizon Cost Model (VCost and/or LCAM) on your PC, you must remove that version prior to installing this version. See the instructions for reinstalling the Verizon Cost Model on CD #1 filename **ReinstallingVerizonCostingModel.doc**, under the folder named **DocumentationFiles**.



Re-installing Verizon Costing Model

- 1) Click on Start on Taskbar
- 2) Point to Settings
- 3) Click on Control Panel
- 4) Select Add/Remove Programs
 - a) Select Verizon Cost Model and click Add/Remove button
 - i) Additional Window will pop up Click Finish
 - b) Select VCost PCD and click Add/Remove button
 - i) If prompted to delete "Shared Components" select Remove None
 - c) Select VCost DTU and click Add/Remove button
 - i) If prompted to delete "Shared Components" select Remove None
 - d) Select LCAM and click Add/Remove button
 - i) If prompted to delete "Shared Components" select Remove None
- 5) When all applications are remove click OK on the Add/Remove Program Properties Window. This will close the window
- 6) Insert the revised CD. The Install Shield wizard will remove the previous installation.
- 7) Remove the CD, then re-insert the CD again to start the automatic startup. Continue the application setup as instructed. Refer to Installing Verizon Cost Model on Windows 95-98.doc or Installing Verizon Cost Model on Windows NT.doc
