**REPLY COMMENTS OF MAURICE SALSA TO REPLY COMMENTS**

I, Maurice Salsa, hereby respectfully submit this Reply to Reply Comments filed by North Texas Radio Group, L.P. ("North Texas") in the above captioned proceeding.

**DISCUSSION**

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 254A to Kiowa, Oklahoma, as that community's first aural broadcast transmission service.

In North Texas Comments to the above captioned proceeding, they proposed Channel 224A in lieu of Channel 254A. In my Reply Comments to North Texas, which I mailed on 10/24/01 and was stamped by the FCC mail room on 10/31/01, I stated that Channel 224A was not available and therefore Channel 254A should be granted as the first aural broadcast transmission service to Kiowa, Oklahoma.

North Texas in their Reply Comments to this proceeding which they filed on 11/6/01 now propose a completely new Channel to replace Channel 254A at Kiowa. They are now proposing Channel 228A in lieu of Channel 254A at Kiowa.

It seems inequitable and unfair that North Texas be allowed to propose yet another Channel at this stage of this proceeding. North Texas did not simply respond to the questions I raised in my Reply Comments but introduced a completely new Channel. North Texas should not be allowed to do this. Therefore, the Commission should strike from the record North Texas' proposal for Channel 228A at Kiowa.


However, the coordinates specified by North Texas in their Reply Comments for Channel 228A at Kiowa, Oklahoma (34 42 58/ 95 54 08) is short by -1.0 Km to Channel 227C KKNB Newcastle and short by -.8 Km to Channel 229C KISR Fort Smith.

The attached Channel study shows that Channel 228A cannot be allotted to Kiowa, Oklahoma in compliance with the Commission's spacing rules at the coordinates specified by North Texas in their Reply Comments.

For the foregoing reasons, I urge the Commission to allot Channel 254A to Kiowa, Oklahoma as that community's first aural broadcast transmission service. Should the Commission allot Channel 254A to Kiowa, Oklahoma, I will apply for Channel 254A, and after it is authorized, will promptly construct the new facility.

The information provided in this Reply to Reply Comments is correct and true to the best of my knowledge.
