PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Maurice Salsa (Petitioner), pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, hereby requests the commission to amend section 73.202 (b) of its rules, the FM Table of Allotments, to allot channel 276A (103.1 Mhz) at Sayre, Oklahoma.

DISCUSSION

Sayre, Oklahoma is an incorporated community of over 4,141 people. Sayre is also the county seat of Beckham County. Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 276A to Sayre, Oklahoma, as that community's first aural broadcast transmission service. Sayre has its own mayor, Jack Ivister, its own post office, its own fire department, its own school district, its own city hall and a number of local churches. The proposed channel 276A will provide additional diversity and an outlet for local self-expression to Sayre residents and therefore is in the public interest.

Attached hereto is a channel study confirming that Channel 276A can be allocated to Sayre, Oklahoma consistent with the FCC's FM separation rules. See revision of FM Assignment Policies and Procedures, 90 FCC 2d 88 (1992).

Petitioner hereby states that if the commission grants this petition, he will apply for the channel when it is allotted, and, if his application is granted, he will promptly build the station.
