PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, Robert Fabian respectfully petitions the FCC to institute a Rule Making proceeding to amend the FM Table of Allotments to add Channel 271A at Mangum, Oklahoma.

DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 271A to Mangum, Oklahoma, as that community's first local aural broadcast transmission service. Mangum, Oklahoma is an incorporated community of over 3,000 people. Mangum has its own mayor, Robert Zinn, its own post office, its own fire department, its own school district, its own city hall and a number of local churches. The proposed channel 271A will provide additional diversity and an outlet for local self-expression to Mangum residents and therefore is in the public interest.


