Dear Mr. Edwards:

This is in response to the request for waiver of the late charge penalty for late payment of Fiscal Year (FY) 2000 regulatory fees, filed on behalf of Concert Global Networks USA LLC.

You state that Concert recently became aware of a discrepancy concerning its international bearer circuit component of the FY 2000 Regulatory Fee and that Concert immediately investigated and took corrective action. Due to the increase in the corrected circuit numbers, you state that an update to Concert's original FY 2000 Regulatory Fee assessment was necessitated, and that Concert thus made an additional payment of \$557,109.00. Because Concert initially paid the fee in full and on time, and promptly remedied the situation when it realized that the data was deficient, you request a waiver of any possible penalty.

We have fully considered all of your contentions. The Communications Act of 1934, as amended, requires the Commission to assess a late charge penalty of 25 percent on any regulatory fee not paid in a timely manner. *See* 47 U.S.C. § 159(c)(1). Moreover, it is the obligation of the entity responsible for regulatory fee payment to ensure that the Commission receives the fee payment no later than the final date on which regulatory fees are due for the year. Your request does not indicate or substantiate that this obligation was met. Therefore, your request is denied.

Payment of late charge penalties in the amount of \$139,277.25 for FY 2000 is now due. The late charge penalties must be filed together with a Form 159 (copy enclosed) within 30 days from the date of this letter.

This memo is to document the requirement and approval of a supplemental payment by Concert to the US federal regulator (Federal Communications Commission - FCC) for the FCC fiscal year 2000 Regulatory Fee. The amount of the supplemental payment is \$557,109.00 USD.

Concert Global Networks USA L.L.C. filed its international bearer circuit component of the FY2000 FCC Regulatory Fees in September 2000 based on AT&T's 1999 43.82 (Circuit Status Report). Section 43.82 of the FCC rules states: "The number of 64Kbs bearer circuits [reported in the 43.82] should be consistent with data used to calculate regulatory fees." AT&T includes Concert circuits in its 43.82 report. A discrepancy surfaced when it was recognized that the leased circuit numbers reported by AT&T in the 43.82 (Circuit Status Report) did not match the 43.61 (International Traffic Data Report). Subsequent to investigation, AT&T filed a revised 43.82 report, which reflected 79,587 additional international bearer circuits for which Concert is liable to pay the FCC Regulatory Fee of \$7.00 each.

The FCC has instructed Concert to remit the supplemental payment accompanied by a completed FCC Form 159 showing only the additional quantity of circuits and fee being submitted. Subsequent to the necessary internal approval and concurrence, payment will be made via wire transfer simultaneous with transmission of the completed FCC Form 159.

Concert Global Networks USA L.L.C. ("Concert"), a global venture of AT&T Corp. ("AT&T") and British Telecommunications ("BT"), filed its international bearer circuit component of the FY2000 Regulatory Fees in September 2000 based on AT&T's<sup>1</sup> 1999 43.82 (Circuit Status Report). (As stated in Section 43.82 of the Commission's rules, "The number of 64Kbs bearer circuits [reported in the 43.82] should be consistent with data used to calculate regulatory fees.") At that time, Concert, in good faith, calculated such fees on data believed to be full and accurate. When it came to our attention, however, that there was a discrepancy between leased circuit numbers reported in the 43.82 (Circuit Status Report) and the 43.61 (International Traffic Data Report), AT&T and Concert immediately investigated and took corrective action, resulting in the re-filing of AT&T's 1999 43.82. The newly reported circuit numbers increased and therefore necessitates an update to Concert's original FY2000 Regulatory Fee assessment.

To fulfill this obligation, Concert now submits a corrected count, and corresponding payment, for international bearer circuits for FY2000. Because we initially paid the fee in full and on time, and promptly remedied the situation when we realized the data was deficient, we respectfully request a waiver of any possible penalty.

Enclosed is a revised Form 159. The corresponding additional payment, calculated to be \$ 557,109.00, will be electronically wired to the Commission.

This is in response to your August 17, 2001 request for waiver of the regulatory fees for FM translator stations K242AC, K247AC, and K262AA, licensed to Cyprus Bagdad Copper Corporation (Cyprus). As you note in your request, in a letter dated September 10, 1996, the Commission's Office of Managing Director granted Cyprus a waiver of the annual regulatory fees for the three translator stations at issue here. You state that prior to December 2, 1999, 100 percent of the stock of Cyprus was owned by Cyprus Amax Minerals Company (Cyprus Amax I). You state that pursuant to an agreement and plan of merger dated September 30, 1999, CAV Corporation agreed to acquire all of the outstanding stock of Cyprus Amax I and its subsidiary companies, including the stock of Cyprus. You state that on December 2, 1999, pursuant to a certificate of merger, Cyprus Amax I merged with and into CAV Corporation, with CAV Corporation being the surviving corporation and Cyprus Amax I ceasing to exist. You explain that as a result of the transaction, CAC Corporation acquired control of Cyprus. You state that on December 2, 1999, CAV Corporation changed its name to Cyprus Amax Minerals Company (Cyprus Amax II). You state that an application for Commission consent to the transfer of control, *nunc pro tunc*, of Cyprus from Cyprus Amax I to Cyprus Amax II (filed on July 13, 2001) is pending before the Commission.


In implementing the regulatory fee program, the Commission stated that it would waive its regulatory fees for any community-based translator station that:

- (1) is not licensed to, in whole or in part, and does not have common ownership with, the licensee of a commercial broadcast station;
- (2) does not derive income from advertising;
- and (3) is dependent on subscriptions or contributions from members of the community served for support.

*Implementation of Section 9 of the Communications Act, Memorandum Opinion and Order*, 10 FCC Rcd 10,891, para. 16 (1995). In your August 17 letter, you state that as before the merger transaction, the three stations are not licensed to, in whole or part, and do not have common ownership with, the licensee of a commercial broadcast station. You state that as before the transaction, Cyprus does not sell advertising on the three stations and that it derives no income from advertising on the stations. You also state that the three translator stations continue to be operated as a nonprofit community service for employees of Cyprus who would otherwise be without radio service. Based upon the statements contained in your request, it appears that after the merger transaction, Cyprus continues to have the type of translator operation for which the Commission proposed to grant relief from the regulatory fee obligation. Under the circumstances, we will therefore waive the regulatory fees for Cyprus's translator stations for fiscal year 2001.

We note that Cyprus is under a continuing obligation to report to the Commission any changes that could affect its qualification for this fee exemption. The merger transaction at issue here occurred in December 2, 1999 and involved the types of changes that the Commission considers in determining whether a licensee remains qualified for a fee exemption for community-based translator stations. Given the year-and-a-half delay in reporting these changes to the Commission, you are admonished to exercise more diligence in reporting to the Commission changes that could affect Cyprus's qualifications for this fee exemption. You should retain this letter, and a copy should be included in any correspondence with the Commission concerning the regulatory fees for your translator service. If you have any questions concerning this matter, please contact the Revenue & Receivables Operation Group at (202) 418-1995.

Cyprus Bagdad Copper Corporation ("Licensee"), by its attorneys and pursuant to 47 C.F.R. §1.1166, hereby requests that the Commission waive, on an indefinite basis, the annual regulatory fee requirement for Licensee with respect to Licensee's FM Translator Stations K242AC, K247AC, K262AA (the "Stations"). In support of this request, the following is respectfully shown:

1. By letter dated September 10, 1996, from Marilyn J. McDermott to Licensee (the "Letter"), a copy of which is attached hereto, the Commission's Office of Managing Director granted a waiver of the annual regulatory fees for the Stations. Specifically, the Letter stated in relevant part:

Cyprus's translator stations are not licensed to, nor do they have common ownership with, any commercial broadcast stations. You also state that Cyprus does not sell advertising and that its stations are operated as a nonprofit community service. Under these circumstances, it appears that Cyprus has the type of translator operation for which the Commission proposed to grant relief from the regulatory fee obligation. Based on your representations, we will waive the regulatory fees for Cyprus's translator stations.

2. In the Letter, the Commission further stated that “[t]he waiver shall remain in effect indefinitely, unless there is a substantial change in the ownership or financing of your translator operation.” Id. In this regard, the Commission is hereby advised of the following:

A. Prior to December 2, 1999, 100% of the stock of Licensee was owned by Cyprus Amax Minerals Company (“Transferor”). Pursuant to an Agreement and Plan of Merger dated as of September 30, 1999, CAV Corporation (a wholly-owned subsidiary of Phelps Dodge Corporation) agreed to acquire all of the outstanding stock of Transferor and its subsidiary companies, including the stock of Licensee. On December 2, 1999, pursuant to a Certificate of Merger, Transferor merged with and into CAV Corporation, with CAV Corporation being the surviving corporation and Transferor ceasing to exist. Accordingly, as a result of this transaction, CAV Corporation acquired control of Licensee. Also on December 2, 1999, CAV Corporation changed its name to Cyprus Amax Minerals Company (“Transferee”).

B. On July 13, 2001, an application was filed with the FCC requesting Commission consent to the transfer of control, nunc pro tunc, of Licensee from Transferor to Transferee. That application is pending before the Commission (See File Nos. BTCFT-20010713ABY, BTCFT-20010713ABZ, BTCFT-20010713ACA). The application is pending before the Commission.

3. In light of the above-described substantial transfer of control of Licensee, Licensee hereby submits the instant request for a new waiver of the regulatory fee requirements for the Stations. In support of this request, it is hereby confirmed that the following conditions still apply with respect to the Stations:

A. The Stations are operated as a nonprofit community service for employees of Licensee who would otherwise be without radio service.

B. Licensee does not sell advertising on the Stations and derives no income from advertising on the Stations.

C. The Stations are not licensed to, in whole or in part, and does not have common ownership with, the licensee of a commercial broadcast station.

D. The above conditions are in accord with the Commission’s policy for waiver requests for FM Translator Stations. See Memorandum Opinion and Order, 10 FCC Rcd 12759, 12762 (Par. 16) (1995).



FY 2001 regulatory fees are not due to be filed with the Commission until the period from September 10, 2001, through September 21, 2001. Accordingly, based on discussions with Commission staff, the instant request is being submitted without the required regulatory fees. This is in response to your request for deferment and waiver of the Fiscal Year 1995 (FY 1995) regulatory fees for FM translator radio stations K262AA, K242AC and K247AC, licensed to Cyprus Bagdad Copper Corporation (Cyprus). You maintain that the translator stations are operated as a nonprofit community service for employees who would otherwise be without radio service; that the stations do not sell advertising; and that the stations have no affiliation with the radio stations whose signals are carried by the translators.

In implementing the regulatory fee program, the Commission stated that it would waive its regulatory fees for any translator station that:

(1) is not licensed to, in whole or in part, and does not have common ownership with, the licensee of a commercial broadcast station; (2) does not derive income from advertising; and (3) is dependent on subscriptions or contributions from members of the community served for support.

Implementation of Section 9 of the Communications Act, FCC 95-257, ¶ 16, released June 22, 1995.

Cyprus's translator stations are not licensed to, nor do they have common ownership with, any commercial broadcast stations. You also state that Cyprus does not sell advertising and that its stations are operated as a nonprofit community service. Under these circumstances, it appears that Cyprus has the type of translator operation for which the Commission proposed to grant relief from the regulatory fee obligation. Based on your representations, we will waive the regulatory fees for Cyprus's translator stations. The waiver shall remain in effect indefinitely, unless there is a substantial change in the ownership or financing of your translator operation. You should retain this letter, and a copy should be included in any correspondence with the Commission concerning the regulatory fees for your translator service.

This is in response to your request dated May 29, 2001, filed on behalf of D.E.B. Cabletech, Inc. (Cabletech) for a partial refund of the fiscal years 1994 through 2000 regulatory fees associated with Cabletech's cable systems serving Cape Fair (MO1068) and Webster County (MO1069), Missouri. You also request a partial refund of the late payment fees associated with the fiscal years 1994 through 1999 regulatory fees for these systems.

In support of your request, you state that Cabletech overpaid its regulatory and late payment fees by miscalculating the regulatory fees due for bulk subscribers in Cape Fair and Webster County. You state that in calculating the regulatory fees, Cabletech divided the annual bulk subscriber fees by the monthly basic subscriber rate rather than by the annual basic subscriber rate as required under the Commission's rules. You state that the miscalculation resulted in overpayment of Cabletech's regulatory fees and late payment fees for Cape Fair and Webster County by \$559.00 and \$2,009.00, respectively. You therefore request a refund in the total amount of \$2,568.00 for the regulatory and late payment fees that Cabletech overpaid for fiscal years 1994 through 2000.

Cable system operators are required to calculate their fiscal years 1994 through 2000 regulatory fees for their bulk-rate customers based upon the basic annual subscription rate for individual customers. *See Assessment and Collection of Regulatory Fees for Fiscal Year 2000, Report and Order*, 15 FCC Rcd 14,478, n.39 (2000); *Assessment and Collection of Regulatory Fees for Fiscal Year 1999, Report and Order*, FCC 99-146, MD Docket No. 98-200, n.48 (adopted June 11, 1999; released June 18, 1999); *Assessment and Collection of Regulatory Fees for Fiscal Year 1998, Report and Order*, FCC 98-115, MD Docket No. 98-36, n.23 (adopted: June 9, 1998; released: June 16, 1998); *Assessment and Collection of Regulatory Fees for Fiscal Year 1997, Report and Order*, 12 FCC Rcd 17,161, n.35 (1997); *Assessment and Collection of Regulatory Fees for Fiscal Year 1996, Report and Order*, 11 FCC Rcd 18,774, n.20 (1996); *Assessment and Collection of Regulatory Fees for Fiscal Year 1995, Report and Order*, 10 FCC Rcd 35,512, para. 75, Appendix H, para. 28 (1995); *Implementation of Section 9 of the Communications Act, Assessment and Collection of Regulatory Fees for the 1994 Fiscal Year, Report and*

*Order*, 9 FCC Rcd 5333 (1994). By computing its 1994 through 2000 regulatory fees for its bulk-rate customers based upon the monthly basic subscriber rate as opposed to the basic annual subscription rate as shown by the documentation attached to your request, we find that Cabletech overpaid its regulatory fees for those years and the associated late payment fees for fiscal years 1994 through 1999. We therefore find that a refund is warranted for the overpayment of the regulatory fees and for the portion of the late payment fees attributable to those overpayments. *See* C.F.R. §1.1160(a)(1). Accordingly, your request is granted.

A check made payable to the maker of the original check, and drawn in the amount of \$2,568.00, will be sent to you at the earliest practicable time. If you have any questions concerning this matter, please call the Revenue & Receivables Operation Group at (202) 418-1995.
