This letter is in response to your request for deferral of the application fee in connection with your proposal for a new AM station in Welch, West Virginia.


You state in your deferral request that the application fee is \$3,010, that the applicant is the owner of a small company that qualified as a new entrant with a 35% bidding credit in the auction process, and that your status has made it difficult to raise the money in time to meet the deadline for submission of the required fee. You request a deferral of the fee pursuant to Section 1.1166(b) of the Commission's rules.

In a follow-up letter, submitted six months later, you request another deferral due to economic hardship. In support, you attach a copy of your U.S. Individual Income Tax Return for 2000, Form 1040 and Schedule C.

Section 1.1166(b), which you cite, provides that deferrals of regulatory fees will be granted for a period of six months following the date that the fee is initially due. The applicable provision governing application fees, however, is Section 1.1117(d), which also provides that deferrals will be granted for a period of time not to exceed six months. With regard to the latter fees, applicants are required to submit payments with their applications. See Section 1.1110(b) of the rules. Your application and initial request for deferral were submitted over six months ago. Therefore, in effect, payment has already been deferred for more than six months. Although you subsequently submitted income tax information in support of another deferral based on economic hardship, the rules do not contemplate a second six month deferral. The fee payment in the amount of \$3,010 is now due. This payment should be submitted together with a Form 159 (copy enclosed) within 30 days from the date of this letter.

This is in response to your September 20, 2001 request for waiver of the regulatory fee for television translator F11MM, licensed to Twelve Mile Ranch, a corporation located outside of Fairplay, Colorado. You state that Twelve Mile Ranch a nonprofit corporation, and that its translator station is not licensed to, in whole or in part, and does not have common ownership with, the licensee of a commercial broadcast station. You also state that Twelve Mile Ranch's translator station does not derive income from advertising, and is dependent on subscriptions or contributions from members of the community served for support.

In implementing the regulatory fee program, the Commission stated that it would waive its regulatory fees for any community-based translator station that:

- (1) is not licensed to, in whole or in part, and does not have common ownership with, the licensee of a commercial broadcast station;
- (2) does not derive income from advertising;
- and (3) is dependent on subscriptions or contributions from members of the community served for support.

Implementation of Section 9 of the Communications Act, Memorandum Opinion and Order, 10 FCC Rcd 10,891, para. 16 (1995). Based upon the statements contained in your request, it appears that Twelve Mile Ranch has the type of translator operation for which the Commission proposed to grant relief from the regulatory fee obligation. Under the circumstances, we will therefore waive the regulatory fees for Twelve Mile Ranch's translator station for fiscal year 2001.

You should note that Twelve Mile Ranch is under a continuing obligation to report to the Commission any changes that could affect its qualification for this fee exemption. You should retain this letter, and a copy should be included in any correspondence with the Commission concerning the regulatory fees for your translator service.
