
We are appealing a decision by the Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) of the Universal Service Administration Co. for Orleans/Niagara BOCES to reduce the discount rate from 50% to 20% for FRN's 692504 and 692505. The SLD denied our appeal on the grounds that we were told they had to have the information by July 13, 2001 and we didn't provide it. This decision should be reversed because we did send all the information in the timeline that the SLD requested.

We received a call from Robert Vaughn of the SLD on June 7th, 2001. He was requesting further documentation to support the 50% discount rate for the sites contained in the two FRN's referenced above. He informed us that we needed letters from each school district that sent students to each of the two BOCES sites. These letters needed to state how many students attended the BOCES sites and how many were eligible for the National School Lunch Program. Due the large number of school districts involved and summer recess being in effect, Robert agreed this information would take some time to collect. Over the next couple of weeks we spoke to Robert weekly and informed him of our progress and he continually granted time to get the information. On July 13, 2001 Robert called and stated the he could not wait any longer and we had 7 days to get him whatever information we had collected. We could have faxed the information on the 20th but Robert suggested that we send the information next day Fed-Ex due to the large amount of information being sent. We sent Robert all the information we had on July 20, 2001 by Fed-Ex overnight per his request.

This decision should be reversed and the data we submitted should be used to determine the appropriate discount rate. We provided the information requested in the proper time frame to the SLD, per Robert Vaughn's request. I have enclosed a copy of the appeal decision as well as the information sent to the SLD.

Thank you for reviewing this appeal and allowing the funding which was properly applied for.

After thorough review and investigation of all relevant facts, the Schools and Libraries Division ("SLD") of the Universal Service Administrative Company ("USAC") has made its decision in regard to your appeal of SLD's Year Three Funding Commitment Decision for the Application Number indicated above. This letter explains the basis of SLD's decision. The date of this letter begins the 30-day time period for appealing this decision to the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC"). If your letter of appeal included more than one Application Number, please note that for each application for which an appeal is submitted, a separate letter is sent.

Funding Request Number: 692504, 692505
Decision on Appeal: **Denied in full**

- Your appeal states that SLD incorrectly modified your discount from the 50% initially requested to 20%. You would like SLD to approve the 50% initially requested.
- The Form 471 you submitted to SLD indicated that you requested a 50 percent discount rate for your funding request. During the original review of your application, you were contacted on 6/7/01, 6/18/01, 7/09/01 and 7/10/01 requesting documentation to support the 50 percent discount rate. Each time the information was requested, the reviewer informed you that the information was needed in 7 days. On 7/10/01, the reviewer informed you that if the information was not received by 7/13/01, a decision would be made based on the available documentation. Since SLD had provided you an opportunity to support your requests during the initial review

process, therefore new information will not be accepted on appeal. Consequently, SLD denies your appeal.

- FCC rules provide that the discount available to an applicant is determined by indicators of poverty and high cost. *See* 47 C.F.R. § 54.505(b). The level of poverty is measured by the percentage of students enrolled in a school or school district that are eligible for a free or reduced price lunch under the national school lunch program or a federally-approved alternative mechanism contained in Title I of the Improving America's Schools Act, codified at 34 C.F.R. § 200.28(a)(2)(I)(B). *See* 47 C.F.R. § 54.505(b)(1). Alternatively, the level of poverty is measured according to participation in Medicaid, food stamps, Supplementary Security Income (SSI), federal public housing assistance or Section 8, or Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP). *See* Federal-State Joint Board on Universal Service, CC Docket No. 96-45, *Report and Order*, FCC 97-157 n.1334 ¶ 374 (rel. May 8, 1997). The high cost determination is made pursuant to rules according to which a school is classified as rural or urban. *See* 47 C.F.R. § 54.505(b)(3). An applicant's discount rate is determined by reference to a matrix based upon the level of poverty and whether a school is classified as rural or urban. *See* 47 C.F.R. § 54.505(c).

If you believe there is a basis for further examination of your application, you may file an appeal with the Federal Communications Commission, Office of the Secretary, 445 12th Street, SW, Room TW-A325, Washington, DC 20554. Please reference CC Docket Nos. 96-45 and 97-21 on the first page of your appeal. Before preparing and submitting your appeal, please be sure to review the FCC rules concerning the filing of an appeal of an Administrator's Decision, which are posted on the website at <www.universalservice.org>. **You must file your appeal with the FCC no later than 30 days from the date on this letter for your appeal to be filed in a timely fashion.**
