On December 10, 2001, Robert Foosaner, Senior Vice President and Chief Regulatory Officer of Nextel Communications, Inc., Regina M. Keeney of Lawler, Metzger & Milkman, LLC, and I met with Roy Stewart, Chief of the Mass Media Bureau, Robert Ratcliffe, Deputy Chief of the Mass Media Bureau, and Jamila Bess-Johnson, Senior Legal Advisor in the Mass Media Bureau regarding a White Paper that Nextel filed with the Commission on November 21, 2001. During our meeting, we summarized the proposals set forth in the White Paper, which is entitled "Promoting Public Safety Communications: Realigning the 800 MHz Land Mobile Radio Band to Rectify Commercial Mobile Radio – Public Safety Interference and Allocate Additional Spectrum to Meet Critical Public Safety Needs." We also distributed at the meeting a copy of a letter dated November 21, 2001 in support of the White Paper from various public safety agencies.
