Dear Ms. Salas:

Pursuant to Section 1.1206 of the Commission's Rules, we are writing to report an *ex parte* meeting on December 12, 2001 with the Commission regarding the above-referenced proceedings. Participating in the meeting were Raju Patel and Jonathan Hakim of A2Q Inc., Catherine Wang and Nancy Killien Spooner of Swidler Berlin Shereff Friedman (collectively, "A2Q"), and James Schlichting, Jared Carlson, and Catherine Seidel of the Commission.

At the meeting, A2Q introduced the Commission to a proprietary technology it has developed that will allow its wireless service customers to access a network of wireless networks. A2Q discussed a broad range of regulatory issues that may facilitate or impede the development of its technology, including wireless local number portability ("LNP"). A2Q also discussed particular applications such as Priority Access. A2Q favors maintaining the current wireless LNP deployment schedule, and not granting the forbearance Verizon has recently requested, because there is no technical barrier to its implementation and wireless LNP will facilitate greater competition in the wireless marketplace. With respect to priority access, A2Q supports Verizon's November 2, 2001 waiver which seeks flexibility in application of the FCC's priority access rules. Because the technology necessary to offer priority access service in strict accordance with the Commission's rules is not yet available, allowances should be made to enable carriers to offer priority access capabilities in the near-term.
