I, Jeraldine Anderson, state as follows:



4. I have not received nor been promised any payment or other consideration in excess of my legitimate and prudent expenses in exchange for the dismissal of my petition.





Agreement

This Agreement is made as of December 12, 2001 between Jeraldine Anderson ("Anderson") and North Texas Radio Group, L.P. ("NTRG") (collectively "Parties").

WHEREAS, NTRG has an interest in a rulemaking proceeding (MM Docket No. 99-233) pending before the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") that involves the upgrade of its radio station KBOC (FM); and

WHEREAS, Anderson is the the sole principal of a rulemaking proceeding pending before the FCC that proposes the allocation by the FCC of a new FM station at Crowell, TX; and

WHEREAS, the FCC staff's processing of the KBOC (FM) rulemaking might be expedited if the Crowell, TX rulemaking proceeding is dismissed with prejudice by the FCC.

NOW THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows.

1. Anderson shall execute and submit to NTRG's counsel, for filing at the FCC, by no later than 5PM EST on Friday, December 14, 2001, a written request to dismiss her Petition for Rulemaking for a new FM station at Crowell, TX ("Request"). Within two (2) business days after the FCC grants the Request, NTRG shall pay Anderson a sum equal to, but not more than, the reasonable and prudent costs of her preparation, filing and prosecution of the pending Petition for Rulemaking for a new FM station at Crowell, TX.

2. The Parties acknowledge that Anderson also shall submit to NTRG's counsel, for filing along with the Request at the FCC, a separate "Declaration of No Consideration In Excess of Costs."

3. This Agreement (i) shall supercede any prior agreements concerning the same subject matter, (ii) shall be binding upon both Parties, their heirs, successors, and assigns and (iii) shall not be modified except by a written document executed by both Parties.

4. This Agreement, which may be executed in counterparts (each of which shall be deemed an original), shall be governed by the laws of the State of Texas.
