CONSENT MOTION FOR FURTHER EXTENSION OF TIME


Outlet Broadcasting Inc. (Outlet), licensee of television station WVIT, Channel 30, New Britain, Connecticut, by its attorneys, hereby respectfully requests a further two-week extension of time, until January 4, 2002, within which to file comments in the above-captioned proceeding. We are authorized to state that Fox Televisions Stations, Inc. ("Fox") and Tribune Television Corporation ("Tribune"), the proponents of the channel allotment proposed in this proceeding, consent to a grant of this request.

Outlet, Fox and Tribune have continued to discuss a proposed accommodation that would forestall the filing of an objection by Outlet to the proposed allotment. It has not yet been possible to conclude these discussions, owing in part to the unavailability of key persons due to the holiday season and an engineering emergency at another Tribune station. In view of the coordination difficulties we continue to anticipate during the holidays, Outlet hereby requests a further two-week extension of time, unit January 4, 2002, within which to file its Comments in this proceeding.

Because this motion is being filed less than seven days prior to the time comments are due, we are orally notifying the Commission's staff pursuant to Section 1.46 of the Commission's Rules.
