**MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER**

Under consideration is a Joint Motion To Dismiss With Prejudice filed on December \_\_, 2001 by Ascom Holding, Inc., Carolina Telephone and Telegraph Company (the Defendant in File No. E-93-43), and United Telephone Company of Florida (the Defendant in File No. E-93-45). This pleading relates to the complaints associated with File Nos. E-93-43 and E-93-45.

The parties to the complaints associated with File Nos. E-93-43 and E-93-45 state that they have reached an agreement resolving the litigation relating to those complaints. They request, therefore, the dismissal of those complaints.

Good cause having been shown, the Joint Motion will be granted and the formal complaints associated with File Nos. E-93-43 and E-93-45 will be dismissed.
