MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER

Under consideration is a Joint Motion To Dismiss With Prejudice filed on December 31, 2001 by New York City Telecommunications Company, Inc. ("NYCTC") and Verizon New Jersey, Inc., Verizon New York, Inc., and Verizon Pennsylvania, Inc (collectively, "Verizon"). This pleading relates to the complaints associated with File Nos. E-93-46, E-93-47, and E-93-48.

In their Joint Motion, NYCTC and Verizon state that they have reached an agreement resolving the litigation relating to those complaints associated with File Nos. E-93-46, E-93-47, and E-93-48. They request, therefore, the dismissal of those complaints.

Good cause having been shown, the Joint Motion will be granted and the formal complaints associated with File Nos. E-93-46, E-93-47, and E-93-48 will be dismissed.
