ORDER

By the Accounting Policy Division, Common Carrier Bureau:

1. This Order dismisses the Request for Review filed by Orange City Christian School (OCCS), Orange City, Iowa.¹ OCCS seeks review of a decision issued by the Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) of the Universal Service Administrative Company (Administrator) on February 5, 2001.² The Commission received OCCS's Request for Review on May 7, 2001.³ Under section 54.720(b) of the Commission's rules, any such appeal must be filed with the Commission or SLD within 30 days of the issuance of the decision that the party seeks to have reviewed.⁴ Documents are considered to be filed with the Commission only upon receipt.⁵ Because the instant Request for Review was not filed within the specified 30-day period, it must be dismissed without further consideration.


