
By the Accounting Policy Division, Common Carrier Bureau:

1. Before the Accounting Policy Division (Division) is a Request for Review filed by the National School Conference Institute (NSCI), Phoenix, Arizona, seeking review of a decision by the Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) of the Universal Service Administrative Company (Administrator) to cancel a funding award in Funding Year 1 of the schools and libraries universal service mechanism.<sup>1</sup> By letter filed January 10, 2002, NSCI requested that its Request for Review be withdrawn.
