


# Plains Region Cable Systems:

43,967 Households Not Passed by *Any* Cable


391,011 Households Passed Only by Analog Cable

# Northern Plains Region Cable Systems:


50,194 Households Not Passed by *Any* Cable


# Northwest Region Cable Systems:
