*Re: Teligent Services, Inc. -- FCC Form 502 Numbering Resource
 Utilization/Forecast (NRUF) Report -- Due February 1, 2002,
 CC Docket No. 99-200.*

Dear Ms. Salas:

By this letter, Teligent Services, Inc. ("Teligent") hereby notifies the Commission that it is no longer required to file the FCC Form 502 Numbering Resource Utilization/Forecast (NRUF) Report with the Commission as Teligent no longer holds any numbering resources, *i.e.*, NPA-NXX codes covered by such report.¹ During the preceding six-month period covered by the currently due NRUF report, due to its Chapter 11 status, Teligent ceased providing local service offerings nationwide. As a result, it has released/ported all assigned telephone numbers in its previously allocated NPA-NXX codes to other carriers and returned all of its unassigned numbering resources to the numbering administrator (Neustar). As such, for the near term, because Teligent will no longer receive or hold any numbering resources from the North American Number Plan Administrator ("NANPA") or from any Pooling Administrator, Teligent will not have any numbering resources for which to report either utilization or forecasts to the Commission and NANPA.²

In its *Report and Order* re Numbering Resource Optimization, the Commission mandated that all carriers that receive numbering resources from the NANPA (*i.e.*, code holders), or that receive numbering resources from a Pooling Administrator in thousand blocks (*i.e.*, block holders), report forecast and utilization data to the NANPA via the NRUF Report semi-annually, on or before February 1 for the preceding six-month

reporting period ending on December 31.³ Because Teligent had numbering resources in the past, it has filed its NRUF Reports as required by the Commission up through the last filing period (August 1, 2001). As a result, Teligent is submitting this letter to ensure that the Commission fully understands that Teligent will no longer file an NRUF for the near term because it no longer has any numbering resources to report and, thus, will have not information to report in future filings, not because it simply failed to timely submit the report.

After informing the affected state Public Utility Commissions and its local exchange customers that it would no longer be able to provide local service,⁴ Teligent immediately began the process of porting numbers assigned to existing customers to alternative carriers pursuant to LSRs (local service requests) received from the customer's new carrier of choice. Teligent also consulted with NANPA to return any unassigned numbers. While Teligent retained a minimal amount of numbering resources during the preceding six month reporting period while its final porting and number-returning process was being concluded, Teligent's sole numbering resource employee was devoted to arranging the appropriate return of the unassigned numbers to NANPA as quickly as possible and assisting in porting the assigned numbers to other carriers. Teligent no longer has any employees that handle numbering resource matters, as it currently does not utilize such resources.⁵

Teligent fully appreciates the importance of the NRUF information to the Commission in determining the current and future availability and delegation of currently assigned numbering resources. However, since Teligent no longer has any numbers and those that it had during the period were in the state of being transferred from Teligent, information about those numbers will not be of any benefit to the Commission. Moreover, for the codes containing assigned numbers that were transferred to other carriers, these numbering resources should appear on their NRUF Reports as these codes are now held by these other carriers.

Teligent is also sending a copy of this letter to NANPA so that it too is fully aware of why the operating company represented by the OCN numbers set forth on the

⁴ Since May 21, 2001, when Teligent filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy protection, Teligent's creditors have been providing funds to keep Teligent operational, making funds available in only two to four week increments. Cognizant of its precarious financial position since entering Chapter 11 in May 2001 and its dependency on its creditors to allow it to continue operating, Teligent obtained Section 214 authority from the Commission to discontinue local exchange service in its local markets if it was required to do so because its creditors decided to no longer make funds available for this purpose.
