Each year nearly 10,000 people perish in devastating fires across this Country. The effectiveness and capabilities of this City's Fire Department is essential to the safety of our community. Established in



the 1930's, the Gonzales Fire Department is a full service organization that provides fire suppression, rescue and



emergency medical services. In addition, we provide to our citizens daily attention in the areas of fire prevention education and participating in public events and gatherings to assure safety and security. We exist to build

partnerships with the community for the betterment of Gonzales. A very important element to our readiness is the training and safety program for our personnel. Daily the members must participate in training evolutions, lectures and study to refresh and learn new and effective fire and rescue techniques. Additional opportunities are afforded so that personnel can attend outside training at LSU Fire and Emergency Training Institute, National Fire Academy as well as such training seminars at the Louisiana State Firemans Association.


The City's fire fighting force is empowered with unique challenges due to such a large tourist and shopping populations that visit. large buildings such as malls and hotels place a serious concern as to fire safety when these establishments are occupied. Our training program addresses this special hazard though aggressive rescue and suppression techniques as will as extensive pre-fire planning program. The on duty Firefighters visit our businesses twice a year to update emergency records and




familiarize themselves with the building. More importantly we establish relationships with our business community that assist them in becoming more successful in their trade. Another successful program that serves the citizens well was established by Mayor Berthelot, where City employees from other departments volunteer to respond




to fire emergencies while on their regular city job. Currently six persons participate in this program, they train every Wednesday with the paid Firefighters and provide much needed support during the day time for our community. The vision for improvement of the City's fire department is the birth child of Mayor Johnny Berthelot, who along with the City Council proposed a special sales tax election on April 7, 2001 to fund a professional full-time fire department. The voters approved this proposition with an overwhelming 86% approval. Immediately the Mayor hired a full-time Chief and Firefighters to



begin building a department for [REDACTED] the future of Gonzales. The marching orders were clear, "Give the Citizens of Gonzales the Best Fire Department." Two basic principles were adopted **Professionalism and Improvement of the City's Fire Insurance Rating**. Simply stated the Gonzales Fire Department will strive every day to serve the needs and missions of this community and



be an asset that the citizens can always depend on and value. We hope that you nor your family will never need our emergency services but we want you to feel confident in the event you do.



The land mass now designated as Ascension Parish was originally a minute portion of the vast territory owned by France. On April 30, 1803, the United States Congress agreed to pay approximately 15 million dollars to France for this territory known as the Louisiana Purchase. The land mass was then subdivided by the U.S. Congress in 1804 into small territories with the present State of Louisiana declared as the Territory of Orleans.

Each territory was then districted into counties and the present Parish of Ascension was within Acadia County. In 1812, Louisiana became the eighteenth state. A new Louisiana State Constitution was adopted in 1845 which changed the designation of counties to parishes. From the former Acadia County, the Parishes of Ascension and St James were created.

Early inhabitants of the Gonzales area were, for the most part, squatters of Spanish and French ancestry, settling amidst the Houma Indians. They were linked to other settlements by footpaths and waterways. The area was basically an agricultural community. By 1851, the confines of this new little settlement had only about ten residents. A small school was established by Adlard Gautreaux in 1855 to educate the children. Homesteading was granted to these early settlers in the mid 1880's with tracts of land ranging from forty to one hundred sixty acres in size.

During the year of 1886, the growing settlement chose to elect "Big" Joseph Gonzales as sheriff.

In 1887, Joseph's son, "Tee-Joe", opened a general store and post office in the small community. Years later, the Railroad Commission ordered the local railroad, the Louisiana Railway and Navigation Company, to change its name from Edenborn to the name of the settlement's post office. As a result the village became known as Gonzales.

Because of the arrival of the Louisiana Railway and Navigation Company, the once isolated community began to grow. The Village was laid off and subdivided by Joseph Gonzales, in 1906. And, it was officially incorporated and declared a village by proclamation of Governor John M. Parker, on April 12, 1922. Joseph Gonzales served as the first mayor of Gonzales. On May 4, 1952, the village became known as the "Town" of Gonzales by proclamation of Governor Earl K. Long.

The leap to a thriving town was made possible by Huey Long with the construction of Airline Highway through the city limits. During the 1950s a major transition occurred to the town as industrial plant began to locate in the area along the Mississippi River; creation revolutionary growth. These industrial corporations induced hundreds of new residents to the town and the population soared rapidly.

In March 1977 the State of Louisiana granted Gonzales a change of status from "town" to "incorporated city". And on August 17, 1977 Governor Edwin Edwards officially proclaimed and designated the newly established "CITY OF GONZALES"!

Rich in history and tradition, diverse in its ethnic background, the dynamic Gonzales area of Ascension Parish is both interesting and exciting. The lifestyle, food and music contains such a lively mixture of native American, French, Spanish, African, Acadian, German and Italian influences as to be totally unique. Today, Gonzales serves as the financial, commercial, industrial, social and political center of the eastern portion of Ascension parish.

Named after Joseph Gonzales, the city of Gonzales "The Jambalaya Capital of the World" is a melting pot of nationalities. Just as jambalaya is a mixture of different meats, spices, and rice, so are the residents who make up this southern and friendly city. On April 12, 1922 Governor John M. Parker declared and proclaimed the status of "Village of Gonzales"; on May 4, 1952, Governor Earl K Long documented the growth of the village allowing for the proclaimed designation as "Town of Gonzales". During the 1950's a major transition occurred as industrial plants began to locate along the Mississippi river; creating a revolutionary growth. These industrial corporations induced hundreds of new residents to the town and the population soared rapidly. Commerce quickly developed, keeping pace with the industrial developments. On the 17th day of August, 1977 Governor Edwin Edwards officially proclaimed and designated the newly established "City of Gonzales". Gonzales is now the commercial hub of Ascension Parish as well as the largest municipality in the parish. Rich in history and tradition, diverse in its ethnic background, Gonzales is both interesting and exciting. The lifestyle, food and music contains such a lively mixture of native American, French, Spanish, African, Acadian, German and Italian influences as to be totally unique.

Located between Baton Rouge and New Orleans, Gonzales, Louisiana is known as the "Jambalaya Capital of the World".

In 1881, a Spanish immigrant, "Tee Joe" Gonzales gave this city its name by forming a new community on his cornfield.(see History)

Gonzales enjoys a prime location near the Mississippi River and the Gulf Coast with strong rail and highway connections linking it to the world. The hard working people of Gonzales find time for recreation, too. Sports of every type abound here and in the naturally temperate climate they are played year round.

The City is best known, however, for the Jambalaya Festival, which it hosts each year to honor the first Cajun settlers.




