

On February 21, 2002, James R. Coltharp of Comcast Corporation and I met with Kyle Dixon, Legal Advisor to Chairman Powell, to discuss the above-captioned proceeding. We reviewed points that have previously been presented in Comcast's prior written submissions in this docket, particularly Comcast's initial filing of December 1, 2000 (especially pages 11-36 and 40-42) and our ex parte report of February 11, 2002. We urged that the resolution of the central issue in this docket not be unnecessarily delayed.
