- 1) historical information on when Sirius and XM had notified the Commission regarding the number and power level of terrestrial repeaters that would be used to supplement satellite Digital Audio Radio Service (DARS) operations; and
- 2) the requests that Sirius and XM had made for experimental licensing, what had been authorized under FCC experimental licenses, and a description of what had been deployed under the experimental licenses.
