On behalf of AT&T Wireless Services, Inc. ("AWS"), Doug Brandon and undersigned counsel met today with Sam Feder, legal advisor to Commissioner Martin, with regard to the above referenced proceeding. At that meeting, AWS discussed the methodology and merits of the PFD Proposal submitted to the Commission by a coalition of WCS licensees and manufacturers on February 19, 2002. AWS explained that by focusing on the signal levels at the victim receivers, this proposal will allow WCS licensees to provide a commercially viable service while also enabling SDARS licensees to achieve their stated target PFD levels for areas served by terrestrial repeaters.
