Yesterday, James Jenkins, Vice President – External Affairs of the United States Cellular Corporation (“USCC”) and I met with Samuel Feder, Legal Assistant to Commissioner Kevin Martin. We discussed the pending petition filed by Verizon Wireless seeking forbearance from the November 24, 2002 deadline for wireless local number portability. In accordance with USCC’s prior comments, we supported forbearance, or in the alternative, a delay in the imposition of number portability requirements on wireless carriers.
