On February 15, 2002, the Commission released a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking to examine the appropriate legal and policy framework under the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, for broadband access to the Internet over domestic wireline facilities.¹ Through this *Notice*, the Commission seeks to classify the provision of wireline broadband Internet access services and to consider the regulatory implications of that classification. It also seeks comment on whether facilities-based providers of broadband Internet access services provided over wireline and other platforms, including cable, wireless and satellite, should be required to contribute to universal service. A summary of the *Notice* is published in the Federal Register today, at 67 Fed. Reg. 9232 (Feb. 28, 2002).

Interested parties may file comments in this proceeding no later than **April 15, 2002**. Reply comments may be filed no later than **May 14, 2002**. When filing comments, please reference **CC Docket No. 02-33**, **CC Docket No. 95-20**, and **CC Docket No. 98-10**.
