ORDER

By the Common Carrier Bureau, Accounting Policy Division:

1. The Accounting Policy Division has under consideration a Request for Review from Shawnee Mission Public Schools (Shawnee Mission), Overland Park, Kansas.<sup>1</sup> Shawnee Mission requests review of a decision by the Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) of the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC or Administrator) relating to Shawnee Mission's request for discounts in Funding Year 3 of the schools and libraries universal service mechanism.<sup>2</sup> Specifically, Shawnee Mission requests that USAC apportion one of its funding requests to a different service provider, because the original service provider no longer provides part of the requested service.<sup>3</sup> Upon our review of the record, however, we find that SLD approved Shawnee Mission's request to adjust the funding request.<sup>4</sup> Accordingly, the Division dismisses Shawnee Mission's Request for Review as moot.
