COMMENTS IN SUPPORT OF REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Proxim, Inc. ("Proxim"), by its attorneys, hereby files these comments in support of the request of extension of time to submit reply comments in the above-referenced proceeding filed by Agere Systems ("Agere Request"), extending the deadline from March 12, 2002 to March 26, 2002.

Proxim is a world leader in wireless local area networking ("LAN") devices and participates actively in the IEEE 802.11 Wireless Local Area Network Standards Working Group and other industry groups that promote LAN products. Proxim is an interested party in this proceeding.

The Agere Request shows that comments filed by XM Radio Inc. and Sirius Satellite Radio Inc. propose drastic reductions in the long-standing limits on out-of-band emissions allowed for unlicensed devices operating under Part 15 of the Commission's Rules and raise a number of complex technical issues that would have a significant impact on the manufacturers of LAN equipment. The Agere Request establishes that additional time is needed to assess these issues

and to provide the Commission with the technical analyses necessary to resolve them
