

PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Maurice Salsa (Petitioner), pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, hereby requests the commission to amend section 73.202 (b) of its rules, the FM Table of Allotments, to allot channel 227C3 (93.3 Mhz) at Matador, Texas.

DISCUSSION

Matador, Texas is an incorporated community of 673 people as of January 1, 1998 according to the Texas State Data Center. Matador is also the county seat of Motley County. Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 227C3 to Matador, Texas, as that community's first commercial FM service. Matador has its own mayor, Rodney Williams, its own post office, its own fire department, its own school district, its own city hall and a number of local churches. The proposed channel 227C3 will provide additional diversity and an outlet for local self-expression to Matador residents and therefore is in the public interest.

Attached hereto is a channel study confirming that Channel 227C3 can be allocated to Matador, Texas consistent with the FCC's FM separation rules. See revision of FM Assignment Policies and Procedures, 90 FCC 2d 88 (1992).


