PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, Linda Crawford respectfully petitions the FCC to institute a Rule Making proceeding to amend the FM Table of Allotments to add Channel 257A at Colorado City, Texas.

DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 257A to Colorado City, Texas, as that community's first competing commercial FM service. Colorado City is an incorporated city of 6,030 people as of January 1, 1998 according to the Texas State Data Center. Colorado City is also the county seat of Mitchell County. Colorado City has its own mayor, Bob Rieley, its own post office, its own school system, its own fire department, its own city hall and a number of local churches.




