COMMENTS

Chesapeake-Portsmouth Broadcasting Corporation ("C-PBC"), by counsel, hereby respectfully submits its Comments in response to the Commission's *Notice of Proposed Rule Making*, DA 02-206, released January 25, 2002 ("*NPRM*"), which proposes that Section 73.202(b) of the Commission's Rules, the Table of Allotments for FM Broadcast Stations, be amended to add Channel 254A at Bunnell, Florida. With respect thereto, the following is submitted:

1. As C-PBC noted in its Petition for Rule Making in this proceeding, the allotment of Channel 254A at Bunnell will provide that community with its first local broadcast transmission service. Further, the proposed allotment can be made in compliance with the Commission's Rules and policies. In addition, Bunnell, which is the county seat of Flagler County, is a growing and thriving community in need of its first local radio service. As set forth in C-PBC's Petition for Rule Making, the community is home to numerous businesses, churches, restaurants, schools, and government offices.

2. C-PBC hereby reaffirms its eagerness to provide a first local radio service to Bunnell. In the event that Channel 254A is allotted to Bunnell, C-PBC will apply for a construction permit

for those facilities upon the opening of a filing window, and, if granted such a permit, will expeditiously construct such facilities in accordance with its permit.

WHEREFORE, the premises considered, C-PBC respectfully requests that the FM Table of Allotments be amended to add Channel 254A at Bunnell, Florida.
