PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Maurice Salsa (Petitioner), pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, hereby requests the commission to amend section 73.202 (b) of its rules, the FM Table of Allotments, to allot channel 272A (102.3 Mhz) at Westbrook, Texas.

DISCUSSION

Westbrook, Texas is an incorporated community of 235 people as of January 1, 1998 according to the Texas State Data Center. Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 272A to Westbrook, Texas, as that community's first aural broadcast transmission service. Westbrook has its own mayor, J.L. Reese, its own post office, its own volunteer fire department, its own school district, its own city hall and several local churches. The proposed channel 272A will provide additional diversity and an outlet for local self-expression to Westbrook residents and therefore is in the public interest.

Attached hereto is a channel study confirming that Channel 272A can be allocated to Westbrook, Texas consistent with the FCC's FM separation rules. See revision of FM Assignment Policies and Procedures, 90 FCC 2d 88 (1992).




