On April 3, 2002, Messrs. Brian O'Connor, Robert Calaff, Mark Cosgrove and Jim Nixon of VoiceStream Wireless ("VoiceStream"), Mr. Robert Rowe of Cambridge Positioning Systems and I, representing VoiceStream, met with Mr. Tom Sugrue, Chief, Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, Ms. Blaise Scinto, Deputy Chief, Policy Division, Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, and Patrick Forster, of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. During the meeting we presented the points contained in VoiceStream's Fourth Semi-Annual Report, filed in the above captioned docket on April 1, 2002. We also reiterated our request that the Commission grant VoiceStream's Amended Request for Limited Modification of Its E911 Phase II Implementation Plan, filed February 28, 2002, and renewed our point that it would be arbitrary and capricious for the Commission to fail to modify our plan to reflect what the Commission has already acknowledged to be the technical reality with respect to the GSM platform, particularly when another GSM carrier is already operating according to a similar schedule.
